I have reviewed the management plan for the Trinity River and have been unable to locate content that addresses the use of motorized equipment within designated wild river corridors of the Trinity and its tributaries. Did I miss it?

Does the forest have a Travel Management Plan or other document that address OHV use within designated wild river corridors? If so, I would appreciate a copy of that document.

Secondly, does the River Management Plan, a Travel Management Plan or similar document address the use of drones or aircraft within designated wild river corridors? If so, I would appreciate receiving a copy of that document as well.

Lastly, does the forest have Administrative Guidelines, policies or procedures that address the use of drones within the bounds of designated wilderness? If so, a copy of these documents would be appreciated as well.
